



DR. JOE MACINNIS JOINS JAMES CAMERON'S 2012 DEEP-SEA EXPEDITION

James Cameron is building a new deep-sea vehicle to make the first scientific survey of the Marianna Trench—seven miles below the surface of the Western Pacific. It will be the first time the deepest canyon inside the deepest ocean has been filmed and sampled

MacInnis spent the first ten years of his career as a diving physician working on the health and safety of industrial and military divers. He also wrote the companion books to Cameron's last two deep-sea expeditions. For the seven-mile scientific survey, Cameron has asked him to participate as safety officer and e-press secretary.
